On the occasion of Carl B. Kern's 143rd birthday, the Kern Fund Advisory Board is very pleased to present to you our 2022 Annual Report. If you're receiving this report for the first time, there's a message especially for you on page 4.

2022 was a challenging year market-wise(!), significantly affecting the Fund's overall balance, which at year's end was \$475,155.36. Nevertheless, thanks to The Dayton Foundation's investment and distribution policies, along with recommendations from the Kern Fund Advisory Board, a record \$21,000 was presented to YMCA Camp Kern last June at camp's Strawberries and Ice Cream event. \$11,000 will be used to provide financial assistance to those children who want to benefit from the camp experience but may otherwise be unable to do so. The remaining \$10,000 will support staff housing renovations. From new Camp Kern Executive Director Todd Brinkman, "We are so blessed to have this donation from the foundation. Looking over the past years of donations it is truly remarkable how much great work has been done through this fund.... I am so grateful for this donation that will make a lasting impact on our camp."

Total distributions to Camp Kern on behalf of the Fund since 1987 have now reached nearly **\$238,000**. This would not have been possible without the generosity of our donors, and 2022 saw a record **112** donors from **24** states donate **\$23,817**, including several first-time donors.

The Kern Fund Advisory Board also welcomed 2 new members in 2022 - Chris Addison, former Camp Kern Executive Director, and Sarah Kuhn, former camper, and great-great-niece of C.B. Kern who represents the Kern family on our Board, filling a position sadly vacated by her father Tom Kuhn who passed away in February, 2022.

For those receiving this report for the first time - likely the result of a past association with YMCA Camp Kern, a Dayton background (including the YMCA and Dayton Foundation), and/or a tolerance of the Advisory Board Chair(!) - we hope you'll take a few minutes to browse through these pages, especially our cumulative summary below summarizing how distributions have been used through the years. We're very proud of our efforts to honor Carl B. Kern and support his work with youth in the camp environment in perpetuity, and we wanted to share our accomplishments with you. You may even recognize some of the names appearing in our donors list and honorary/memorial gifts, spanning periods of Camp Kern's and Dayton's history, who have both served as role models and contributed to the success of our efforts.

Use of Distributions from The Carl B. Kern Fund

Since the first distribution check of **\$201** was presented to then Executive Director Larry Maxwell at camp's Strawberries and Ice Cream event in June, 1989, approximately **\$238,000** in funds have been used to support many efforts, among them:

- Camper scholarships (camperships) requests (1989-present) \$95,500
- The Harry Schiewetz Assembly Hall Carl B. Kern Auditorium (2005-2007) \$50,000
- The Charles Snyder Recreation Hall (2012-2015) \$25,000
- The Camp Kern Centennial Campaign (2008-2010) **\$15,000**
- The Camp Kern Lodge Renovation Campaign (1999-2001) \$14,500
- Renovation of Onsite Staff Housing (2022) \$10,000
- The Circle K Ranch Improvement project including "Sponsor a Stall" (2021) \$10,000
- The Dayton YMCA Capital Campaign (1996-1998) \$10,000
- Partial funding for directional signage and the Climbing Tower (2002,2003) \$6,000
- Kern camper/staff participation in World Camp 1994 and 1998 (1994,1998) \$2,000
